

Swimming and Sauna Rules

der Yachthotel Chiemsee GmbH („Company “)

I. Scope of Application

- (1) These Bathing and Sauna Rules are an integral part of the General Terms and Conditions and apply to the use of the company's entire bathing and sauna area, including the immediate entrances, the sunbathing lawn, the whirlpool, the outdoor pool, and the docks.
- (2) Access is permitted exclusively between 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.
- (3) In urgent cases, the company reserves the right to restrict access, in whole or in part, either in terms of time or location.

II. Authorized Users

- (1) Only guests of the company are authorized to use the facilities. This authorization applies only for the duration of their booked or agreed-upon stay, or, failing that, for the customary length of stay. This does not apply to guests who suffer from contagious diseases or contagious skin rashes, have open wounds, or are under the influence of alcohol, medication, or drugs, including legal drugs (e.g., cannabis). If there is any doubt regarding the presence of such a condition, the company may require the prior presentation of a medical certificate.
- (2) Non-swimmers and inexperienced swimmers are strongly advised against swimming in Lake Chiemsee due to the increased risks (wind, weather, waves, boat and ship traffic, currents, shallow areas, etc.). Swimming in Lake Chiemsee is at your own risk. **There is no lifeguard service there.**
- (3) Guests under the age of 14 may enter the swimming and sauna areas only when accompanied by a responsible adult.
- (4) Guests with mental or physical disabilities may use the swimming facilities only when accompanied by a suitable caregiver.
- (5) Dogs and other pets are prohibited throughout the entire swimming and sauna area.

III. Prohibitions and Rules of Conduct

- (1) Instructions from staff, as well as all separate notices of prohibition and rules of conduct, must be strictly followed. Guests who violate these rules may be expelled from the swimming and sauna areas.
- (2) The following are strictly prohibited:
 - a) Unauthorized access to the boat docks. Access is permitted only to boat owners.
 - b) **Children under 14 years of age and non-swimmers are prohibited from entering the swimming dock. Swimming in Lake Chiemsee from the swimming dock poses additional risks to life and limb (deep water, wind, weather, waves, boat and ship traffic, currents, shoals, etc.)!**
 - c) Jumping into, pushing, or throwing other guests into the swimming pool, the hot tub, or from the swimming dock.
 - d) Photographing or filming other guests without their express consent.
 - e) Running (racing) in any area with a smooth or slippery surface (e.g., the swimming dock).
 - f) Swimming in the outdoor pool, the hot tub, or Lake Chiemsee, as well as staying near the water or on the sunbathing lawn, when thunderstorms are approaching. **In such cases, there is a risk of death!**
 - g) Bringing food and beverages in breakable containers.

- h) Smoking outside of the areas specifically designated for that purpose. This also applies to e-cigarettes.
 - i) Any misuse of the available swimming facilities and attractions. Use is at your own risk.
 - j) Reserving chairs and lounge chairs.
- (3) Guests must refrain from any conduct that is contrary to public decency or that jeopardizes the safety, order, tranquility, and cleanliness of the pool and sauna area. In particular, guests must refrain from:
- a) Swimming and sunbathing area:
 - Any contamination, particularly of the water. Before using any swimming pool, guests must thoroughly clean their bodies.
 - b) Sauna area:
 - Entering the sauna rooms while wearing clothing or shoes of any kind.
 - Using the loungers and seating in the steam rooms without a sufficiently large cloth covering (e.g., bath towel, sauna towel, etc.).
- (4) Please note the following:
- a) The use of certain facilities (such as hot tubs and saunas) poses increased health risks for pregnant women and guests suffering from other, particularly chronic, medical conditions (e.g., acute infections, fever, cardiovascular diseases, epilepsy, severe hypertension). You therefore use these facilities at your own risk. This also applies to participation in classes and special events. In justified cases, the company may require the presentation of a medical certificate as a condition of participation (see Section II. 1.).
 - b) Various areas of the pool complex are under video surveillance for security reasons and in compliance with data protection regulations. These areas are clearly marked.
 - c) **ATTENTION! There is no permanent lifeguard supervision in the following areas:**
 - **Indoor pool**
 - **Hot tub**
 - **Swimming dock**
 - **Beach area on Lake Chiemsee**
 - **Outdoor pool**
 - d) There is an increased risk in the swimming and sauna areas due to wet and/or slippery surfaces. Special caution is advised here.
 - e) The changing rooms and lockers are not suitable for the secure storage of money, jewelry, and other valuables. The company is not liable for lost items. Guests are therefore strongly advised to either lock such items in their room safe or enter into a separate safekeeping agreement (hotel safe) with the company. The room key should be handed in at the front desk while guests are in the pool and sauna area.
 - f) Items still in a locker after the facility closes for the day will be treated as lost and found.

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
